

A Typical Day at Koinonia Day Camp

- 8:00-8:30 Campers arrive, opening activity
- 8:30-11:30 Every 45 minutes is a different activity
- 11:30-12:15 Lunch and clean-up
- 3:15-3:30 Afternoon Break
- 3:30-4:15 Group Activity
- 4:15-5:00 Free Choice- wind down time, quiet activities. Four square, sidewalk chalk, sit down and chat. All campers are in a central location for pick up!

Age appropriate ACTIVITIES INCLUDE but are not limited to: Basketball, soccer, whiffleball, kickball, duck~duck~splash, SPUD, dodgeball, volleyball, funnel ball, Mr. Fox, shark attack, 7-up, musical chairs, ultimate tag, ultimate frisbee, capture the flag, flag tag, flag football, cross-over dodge, bases and baskets, etc...

~ Swimming ~

Campers swim recreationally for 45 minutes every day. Swim lessons are available to campers for an additional fee of \$25 per week.

~ Arts & Crafts ~

Campers have one 45 minute rotation of art daily. Weekly art contests are held and voted on by parents and staff ~ awards are presented on Fridays.

~ Archery ~

Campers must be 8 years old or older to participate in archery. Archery “Bull’s Eye” and achievement awards are presented on Fridays.
