

Behavior Management & Camp Rules

Children are expected to be respectful of other campers and Koinonia staff
Stay with their group at all times
Clean up the area in which they have played or have had their lunch
Use appropriate language at all times
Keep their hands to themselves
Respect each others' personal space

Disciplinary Actions

Certain Actions as stated in our Zero Tolerance Policy will result in campers being sent home immediately

First reported infraction - Verbal warning/ Time Out

Second reported infraction – Written Warning/ Time Out/ Parent is notified

Third reported infraction - Written Warning/ Time Out or sent to office/ Parent will be called to pick up their child

Fourth reported infraction – Written Warning/ Sent to the office/ Parent will be called to pick up their child and be suspended from program for one more day

If a child is removed twice in one week , he/she will not return for the remainder of that week

Any continuous problems with a camper may result in expulsion from our summer camp program

There are no refunds for being removed from camp due to behavior

Zero Tolerance Policy

In order to provide a happy and safe social environment for all campers and staff, this policy will be strictly adhered to. This policy will include, but not limited to inappropriate language and behavior, sexual harrasment, verbal abuse and blatant acts of aggression. If found being aggressive the parents will be called to remove the child for the remainder of the day for the first offense. Lesser violations will be handled as stated above.

If the child is in need of being picked up because of their behavior, Koinonia policy dictates a one hour time frame. A fee of \$15 per hour will be assessed if that time frame is not adhered to unless Koinonia has approved an extension for that parent.
